



This game can be played regarding all covid measurements and completely safe. As you will be able to play from home via video call!


Hack Game Trailer 1 (control+click to play)

How is this conducted?

This is conducted via zoom as the communication channel. The team leader of each team will be given a secret hacking URL and an access code to access the hack game and shares his screen with his team members.

How many can play at the same time?

We can have 4 to 5 pax per team. So, if you have let's say 20 pax, this will be divided into 5 groups of 4 pax. If you pay 100 pax, this will be divided into 20 groups of 5 pax. The fastest group to escape(hack) successfully wins!
